TSECL RISING BEATING DISCOMS OF MANY DEVELOPED STATES

India's power sector has had a lot to celebrate over the last few years. It has achieved universal coverage, improved supply reliability, linked existing grids to create a single pan-India grid, accelerated the deployment of essential technologies, and attracted investments from both global and local sources. The ministry of Power, Government of India released its *Tenth Annual Integrated Rating & Ranking of Power Distribution Utilities* in August 2022. It covers 71 power distribution utilities comprising of 46 State Discoms, 14 Private Discoms and 11 Power Departments across all States/ UTs of India. Since, 2012 Integrated Rating Exercise is being carried out under the framework approved by the Ministry of Power annually with the aim of promoting financial well-being in corporatized state Discoms.

As per the current report of August 2022, the rank of Tripura State Electricity Corporation Limited (TSECL) has been upgraded to '22' with Grade of 'B-' where as the rank of TSECL was '39' and Grade 'C' in the last year's *Ranking and Ninth Annual Integrated Rating* published in July, 2021. Hard work and sincerity of TSECL employees as a team under the dynamic leadership of *Shri Debashis Sarkar* has made it possible in such a short span of time.
